

# INFORMATION ON OUR WORKSHOP

Making the Most of Mealtimes: Gaps in Care and Better Practices for Improving Nutritional Intake in Residents Living in Long Term Care by Heather Keller, RD, PhD

The Making the Most of Mealtimes (M3) study is the most comprehensive data collection to date worldwide that provides new insights into how we can improve the nutritional care of older adults living in LTC residences. This research provides evidence to back up current best practices while suggesting areas for further development and testing of innovative strategies. This in-depth look at this evidence and the policy and best practice implications will be the focus of this presentation.

### The End Stage Renal Disease and Long Term Care Mix: Implications for Nutrition Care by Evelyn Spanner, MSc, RD

Demand for long term care (LTC) by patients with end stage renal disease (ESRD) is likely to increase with growing numbers of seniors initiating chronic dialysis. Over the last 9 years, there has been a 54% increase in the number of seniors with kidney failure. These patients present some unique nutrition challenges for the RD working in the dialysis unit and for the RD in LTC. Many of the older adults with ESRD have a high burden of comorbidity and disability and are at risk for malnutrition, hyperkalemia, hyperphosphatemia and volume overload. This session will focus on the nutrition care of ESRD patients in order to manage their nutrition issues and tailor interventions in LTC to keep the patient eating well.


